INSTRUCTIONS: To request electronic delivery of notices permitted to be delivered by the Chief Appraiser, complete this form and click submit. Please note, this request is specific to the property identified on this form and is not transferrable.

Texas Property Tax Code Sec. 1.086. On the written request of the owner of a residential property that is occupied by the owner as the owner's principal residence. The chief appraiser of the appraisal district in which the property is located shall send each notice required by this title related to the following to the e-mail address of the owner:

- (1) a change in value of the property;
- (2) the eligibility of the property for an exemption; or
- (3) the grant, denial, cancellation, or other change in the status of an exemption or exemption application applicable to the property.

This request **WILL NOT** be applied to notices from the Montgomery County Appraisal Review Board (example: Hearing Notices, Final Orders, etc.).
